Vaccination and Check up Schedule

Well Child Check-up and Immunization Schedules

As part of our well child care, check-ups are given at regularly scheduled intervals and vaccinations are an essential component of the care we provide for our patients. The following calendar indicates the ages for routine check-ups and the vaccinations that are normally given at those visits.

Each check-up includes a growth and weight evaluation, a full developmental assessment and a complete physical examination.

AGE Immunizations/Screening Tests

Birth (in hospital) Hearing screen, congenital cardiac screen, newborn blood screen, Hep B

vaccine

1st 1-2 weeks Post Hospital exam, weight check, bilirubin check

4 weeks \* Review of screening tests, Hep B vaccine
2 months DTaP, Hib, IPV, Prevnar, Rotateq vaccines
4 months DTaP, Hib, IPV, Prevnar, Rotateq vaccines
5 months DTaP, Hib, IPV, Prevnar, Rotateq vaccines
9 months Hearing screen, Dental varnish; Hep B vaccine

12 months\* CBC, Lead screen, Dental varnish; Hep A, Prevnar vaccines Dental varnish; DTaP, Hip, IPV, MMR, Varicella vaccines

18 months Hearing screen, dental varnish; Hep A vaccine

2 years CBC, lead screen, dental varnish

3 years Vision and hearing screen, dental varnish

4 years\* Vision and hearing screen, CBC, urinalysis; DTaP, IPV, MMR, Varicella

vaccines

5 years Vision and hearing screen, CBC, urinalysis

\*The 4 weeks, 12 months and 4 years exams should NOT be done before those birthdays.

6-8 years Vision and hearing screen, CBC, urinalysis

9-11 years Vision and hearing screen, CBC, urinalysis, lipid profile; HPV (Gardisil) 11-12 years Vision and hearing screen, CBC, urinalysis; Tdap, Menactra, HPV

vaccines

12 and up Vision and hearing screen, CBC, urinalysis

16-18 years Menactra, Trumemba vaccines

18-20 years Vision and hearing screen, CBC, urinalysis, lipid profile
